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

Remove packing materials. Please wipe the plates with a well-wrung cloth before using the appliance for the first time and dry well.



Ingredients


Breads

- Select suitable size of bread to fit on the plate. (Approx. 11 cm×12 cm) Do not protrude from the frame.
- For golden toasted sandwiches, spread butter or margarine lightly on out side of the breads.

Fillings

- The ingredients which contain a lot of liquid are not suitable for filling. (The liquid may leak out.)
- •When using too much cheese or chocolates will overflow and scorch on the plate.
- For large size of ingredients, cut them into small pieces.
- •When using raw ingredients such as meat, precook before toasting.

3 OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS How to Use



Note

• Do not leave the lid open for long period of time after the sandwich maker is pluged in. (The handle will get hot.)

Toast sandwiches.

- Hold the handle and close the lid slowly until it latches.
 Otherwise upper breads may be off the alignment.
- Allow the sandwiches to toast for 3~8 minutes.
 Adjust toasting time depending on your taste.



- If the lid is difficult to close, you may have added too much fillings used thick fillings or the breads are too thick. Do not force to close the lid.
- Beware of the hot steam which may come out from side or top surface of the sandwich maker.

After finish toasting, unplug.

- •When toasting is finished, remove the sandwiches carefully.
- Use plastic or wooden utensils. Do not use metal utensils as they will scratch and damage the non-stick plates.

4 MAINTENANCE How to Clean


■ Unplug the power plug and make sure the sandwich maker is cool down completely.

Note

- Do not use benzine, thinner, alcohol, bleach, polishing powder, metal brush or nylon brush, otherwise the surface will be damaged.
- Do not use a dishwasher.

Exterior

Wipe with a well-wrung cloth.



Plates / Interior

Wipe with a well-wrung cloth.

- Do not fill up with water in the plates or wash under the running water.
- •Use plastic or wooden utensils if necessary.


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
Do not use metal utensils as they will scratch and damage the non-stick plates.


The product date code is impressed upon the bottom face of the unit.

6.1. Basic wiring diagram



Caution


Make sure that the cables are routed as they were before the repair. Otherwise, the lead wire may touch the end face of parts, resulting in a failure or electric shock.


